Ernakulam Karayogam gladly announces the launch of Navathi Memorial Guest House at Karakkat Road, Thekkenada, Guruvayur. The foundation stone of the Guest House was laid on 14.12.2017. The proposed Guest House will have 36 Fully Furnished Air Conditioned Double Rooms with state-of-the-art facilities such as LCD TV, Wi-Fi, Telephone. Hot water, Lift, Car parking, etc. Conveyance to the temple from 3.00 a.m. to 6.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. is an added advantage. Proximity to Railway Station, KSRTC and Private Bus Stands is another attraction.







The construction is expected to be completed by 25th December 2019. The Ernakulam Karayogam has introduced "Privilege Card Scheme" to facilitate the use of Guest House at Special Tariff Rate. As per the scheme, a maximum number of 750 Privilege Cards will be issued, which will enable the holders to occupy the Guest House room for 12 days in a year for 10 years, In order to be eligible to get the allotment of Privilege Card, the person has to make a non-refundable deposit of Rupees One Lakh to Ernakulam Karayogam.
